Please note the following additions to the Reopening Plan:

- If your child has an exposure to someone either in school or outside of school, the best time to get tested is 6-8 days after exposure OR if your child is showing any symptoms. **Please note that if you choose to test your child this does not change the 14 day quarantine period.** Symptoms can develop after a negative test is reported during the 14 day period.
- If your child is exposed and you choose to get your child tested for peace of mind, siblings ARE allowed to come to school.
- If your child, or another family member who lives in your house, is getting tested because they **HAVE** symptoms, then **ALL** children need to stay home until we have the results.
