Dear parents,

For Mrs. Geesey, students **MUST** read *The Giver* by Lois Lowry and choose **one** other book from the **Middle School Suggested Summer Reading Book List** to read over summer vacation. Please have your child bring *The Giver* with them to school in September. Students will need to complete a novel response for the one additional book that they decide to read. The novel response template is posted in the 2024-2025 Cohort Study Halls in Google Classroom. This will count as a test grade in reading. Students do not need to complete a novel response for *The Giver*; instead, students will have a test on *The Giver* when they return in September. The date of the test is to be determined, and students will receive a study guide to help them review for the test at the beginning of the year. If students have any questions or concerns about reading class, they may email Mrs. Geesey over the summer at theresa.geesey@scjnschool.org.

For Mrs. Sanchez, students will need to complete **ten** Summer Solutions grammar lessons. All ten lessons need to be completed in pencil, and each question must be answered completely to receive full credit. These lessons will be checked during the first week of school and will be corrected as a class with Mrs. Sanchez. This packet will count as a test grade in writing class.
