



Kindergarten Supplies 2025-2026

Dear parents,

We are looking forward to an exciting school year with your children. Below you will find detailed information about school supplies. Attached are some helpful tips to help prepare your child over the summer as well. Thank you for getting your child ready for kindergarten!

The following supplies need to be purchased by you **before** the first day of school:

- 3.5mm plug headphones for Technology class and devices - Each student will need a set of headphones for technology class. Primary (K-3) On-ear headphones, 3.5mm plug, (under \$5.00), Example brand: Koss (found on Amazon). Please put the headphones in a quart-size, slider, ziplock bag. **Label the bag with first and last names using a permanent marker.**

In addition, please send in the following supplies on the first day of school:

- 3 containers of Clorox wipes
- 3 boxes of tissues
- 1 baby wipes (boys only send in)
- 1 roll of paper towels (girls only send in)

All students need a change of clothes. Please send in a ziplock bag of extra clothes/underwear, and socks. The change of clothes does not have to be the uniform. Thanks!

All other supplies, such as copybooks, folders, pencil cases, pencils, crayons, markers, and so on, **will be purchased through the school and will be here on the first day of school.** We prefer all students in Kindergarten to have the same school supplies at this age. Looking forward to a great school year!!

Personal Needs Without Help can they...

- Put on and take off coat
- Tie their own shoes
- Wash their hands
- Snap, button, zip, and buckle

Social Skills can they...

- Listen to an adult & follow simple instructions
- Cooperate with other children
- Sit for short periods of time
- Follow simple two-step directions

Intellectual Skills do your children...

- Sit and listen to a story
- Say the ABC'S
- Hold a book upright and turn the pages
- Holds scissors & pencil appropriately
- Know their first and last name
- Recognizes and writes first name
- Tell and retell familiar stories
- Know colors, shapes and sizes
- Counts 0-10
- Recognizes the letters within their name
